Appendix 4. THE REPORTABLE CONDUCT SCHEME (Victoria)

THE REPORTABLE CONDUCT SCHEME outlines a series of responsibilities for the 'head of entity' (Senior Pastor) to undertake, where an allegation has been made about child abuse against a person who is acting for the College or participating in activities run by the College.

The following information is provided by the Commission for Children and Young People.

What is the head of an organisation required to do?

The head of the organisation is required to:

- have systems in place to:
 - prevent reportable conduct from being committed
 - enable reportable allegations to be made
 - investigate and respond to reportable allegations
 - report allegations of criminal conduct or suspected criminal conduct to police
- ensure allegations are appropriately investigated
- notify the Commission of reportable allegations and provide updates and outcome of the findings.
